

ISM Policy

EUROPRINT represents a new dimension of process and technological solutions in the field of printing. This dimension provides and ensures such solutions that guarantee the best quality - price ratio on the market.

ISM (integrated management system) includes QMS - quality management system, EMS - environmental management system, OHSAS - occupational health and safety management, ISMS - information security management, ISO 12647-2 Process control for the production of half-tone colour separations, proof and production prints. Throughout all its activities, related services and product usage and their manufacturing, the organisation strictly obeys the environmental protection, occupational health and safety, and information security. The organisation management is obliged to:

- Create an effectively-functioning company using the existing fundamentals, with an operative reaction to the market demands, and to provide maximum satisfaction to clients with respect to quality, terms, and capacity. This is to be carried out by the implementation of modern managerial methods into all parts of the internal company management, EUROPRINT production system, effective quality production management, and processes and stabilisation of human resources.
- Follow the path of environmental protection and take responsibility in this field. We consider the respect of the requirements of legal regulations and other environmental requirements as the basis of continual process of constant improvement of the environmental protection. EUROPRINT agrees to fulfil these targets and to continuously improve the environmental management system and pollution prevention.
- Respect the requirements of legal regulations, contractual safety requirements of clients, and other requirements. We agree to prevent the incidence of work-related injuries and harm to health.
- Perceive the protection of client's information and information itself as a complete and controlled set of balanced measures whose target is to protect reasonably all important assets. The priority is to protect personal and company data of our clients. The basic task is to ensure the availability, integrity and confidentiality of the data.


In order to do that:

- We shall continuously enforce the environmental criteria for all economic activities including their constant monitoring and evaluation so that the negative effects of our business activity to the environment are permanently decreased
- By implementing system measures we shall create conditions for the minimization of future environmental burdens.
- We shall ensure the maximum natural source protection, especially in the field of electricity consumption.
- We shall ensure the necessity of sources for the realisation of this Policy, and provide such sources in the optimum volume in order to ensure the fulfilment of this Policy.
- We shall carry out the applicable provisions of all general legally-binding regulations and other obligations related to the occupational health and safety
- We shall include the issue of work-related injuries as a criterion of the evaluation of company culture with the aim that each employee, when performing work-related task, feels his/her own personal liability for the prevention of work-related injuries, occupational diseases, or other extraordinary events
- We shall increase the security level of protected data and decrease the risk arising out of risk analysis
- We are registering to the global FSC programme in the chain of ecological logging.

We shall share the Integrated Management System Policy with all persons working for or on behalf of the organisation and with all persons performing work-related activities or other connected activities, and to persons who are present at our workplaces or premises and of whom the organisation is aware, and we shall enforce the Policy even with respect to our suppliers of products and services and external resources. The public shall be informed of the Integrated Management System Policy adequately as well as the state administration authorities and self-government authorities, and our customers.
